

2012 Celebrating Heroes Triathlon Entry Fees

USAT Annual Members: \$125.00 (US)

Non-USAT Members: \$135.00 (includes \$10 for one day USAT event insurance)

USAT Military: \$115.00

Non-USAT Military: \$125.00 (includes \$10 for one day USAT event insurance)

Relay Team: \$225.00 (assumes all USAT Annual members)

Relay Team composed of 2 USAT members and one non-USAT member: \$235.00.

Relay Team composed of 1 USAT member and 2 non-USAT members: \$245.00

Relay Team composed of 3 non-USAT Members: \$255.00

After 3/01/12: All Celebrating Heroes Triathlon Race Entry fees will increase \$15.00.

REFUNDS:

A refund of your race entry fee, less a \$65 administrative charge, will be processed upon receipt of your request submitted by filling out our refund request form.

The request for refund must be made on or before May 11, 2012. After May 11, 2012, no refunds will be processed for any reason.

Any & All CTA race entries and entry fees are non transferable between events, or between athletes. Entries cannot be rolled over to another year.

Selling of your race entry slot is strictly prohibited. If you do sell your race slot, you will be disqualified from the race and you, as well as the entrant who purchased your slot, will be disqualified from other CTA events for a minimum of 2 years.

There are NO refunds given for community/charity slots since this money is allocated directly toward charity.

Please understand this policy prior to signing up for the race.

Race management reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.

There is NO rain date, We go rain or shine. In case of inclement weather, management reserves the right to alter/modify the race/course for safety concerns. In the case of a "Natural Disaster"/Local Incident/Terrorist Act, there will be No Refunds of race entry fees. Athletes must accept any such risk of their entry fee paid.

Monies for charitable organizations we support have already been pledged, and monies collected are used to develop and produce the event, including all race supplies, staffing, and administration. We pledge to make every effort to produce a fair, safe and exciting event.

Any decision we make to go forth with the race is based on the overall event/race course safety, in concert with local risk management, police, fire and rescue, and medical team
